Job Introduction:

The successful candidate will be responsible for the installation, programming and commissioning of security systems across Tutela's customer base.

Role Responsibility:

- Self performs and also project manages subcontractors in the installation of intrusion detection, access control, digital video, CCTV and data communication systems. On-site work will include installation and configuration of head-end computer systems, installation, termination, and calibration of field devices and sensors, and installation of communication infrastructure including conduit, enclosures and fiber optic cables.
- Assists System Engineers with installation plans.
- Assists in site surveys and the development of cost estimates associated with procuring equipment and the installation of materials.
- Completes job status reports, customer satisfaction/project acceptance/quality assurance documents, travel expense reports, safety logs, and other documentation as required.
- Organizes and coordinates weekly meetings to discuss installation activities, changes, and developments with the customer and site personnel.
- Communicates with customer upon arrival and before leaving the work site. Continuous proactive customer interactions including an in-depth understanding of customer(s) needs, wants and systems currently in place. Plans for future needs with customer that include recommending complete systems enhancements and technology roadmaps.
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.

The Ideal Candidate:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. 3+ years of experience as a project manager in the security industry and the flexibility and responsibility to manage multiple projects at the same time.

Education and/or Experience:

Associates degree in electronics, electrical systems or related field with four years of field experience or equivalent combination of collegiate education and experience is strongly preferred. Must have extensive knowledge of electronics, electrical systems, computer programming, as well as site management and installation experience. Experience in dealing with Fortune 500 and enterprise wide security systems. Employee should also be adept in the use of the following or similar systems: Vanderbilt, AMAG, DSX, Salient Systems, Genetec, Avigilon, DMP as well as others. Successful candidates must be able to pass drug screening, possess a valid driver's license.

Language Skills:

Ability to read, analyze, and interpret engineering and construction drawings and specifications. Communicates effectively in both oral and written English technical language, both in interpreting requirements and providing reports.

Physical Demands:

The incumbent is occasionally required to stand for long periods of time. The incumbent may be required to lift and/or move up to 10 lbs. And occasionally lift and/or move up to 25 lbs. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions.

Work Environment:

While performing the duties of this job, the incumbent regularly may split time between the office and the customer's job site. Travel is required.
